How is Jesus the perfect expression of God's love?

“No man hath seen God at any time, the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.”

God, being pure spirit, is invisible to physical eyesight. Not even Abraham, “the friend of God,” **not even Moses**, “whom the LORD knew face to face” (Deuteronomy 34:10) could see the divine glory in its fulness. When Moses asked that he might see the glory of God, he was told, “you cannot see my face; for man shall not see me and live” (Exodus 33:20). He was instructed instead to stand in a hollow in the rocky slope of Sinai while the glory of God passed by, and there, said God, “I will cover you with my hand until I have passed by; then I will take away my hand, and you shall see my back; but my face shall not be seen” (Exodus 33:22 f.). We should perhaps say ... that Moses saw, so to speak, the afterglow of the divine glory. To this extent was it true that Moses could “behold the form of the LORD” (Numbers 12:8); but the glory on which even Moses could not look has now been displayed among men and women.

“Who has seen him and can describe him?” asked Ben Sira concerning God (Sirach 43:31). He left his question unanswered, but now an answer is forthcoming, for **one who has not only seen him but has his being in his bosom has declared him.** (F. F. Bruce, *The Gospel of John*, 88)

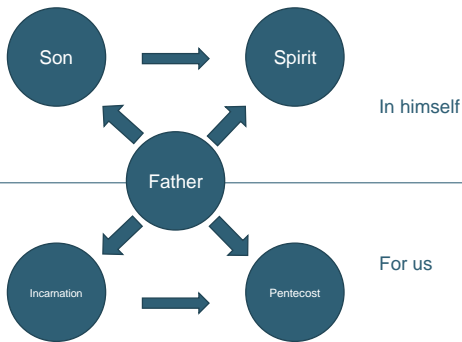
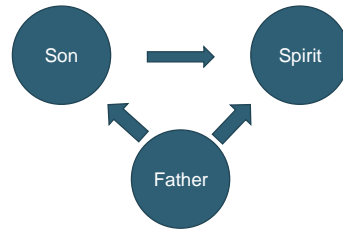
