


Zurich, Switzerland (1519)





DEBATES WERE NORMAL




"Brother, you are in error there."

THERE DEBATED





In January of 1525, a mandate was issued: "All children will be baptized. Those who refuse will be punished."

In January 21, 1525, the group met in the house of Felix Manz...


They were labeled "Anabaptists."
